RECOMMENDED ORDER
DISMISSING COMPLAINT

This proceeding involves a complaint filed under the “whistleblower” employee protection provisions of Section 405 of the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982, 49 U.S.C. § 31105, and its implementing regulations, 29 C.F.R. part 1978.

The Complainant is represented by counsel. At a telephonic conference on November 3, 2008, the parties informed me this matter had been settled. The parties subsequently executed a settlement agreement and “Joint Stipulation of Dismissal,” both of which were forwarded to me, as required under 29 C.F.R. § 1978.111.

I find the parties have settled this matter to their satisfaction. I further find the parties have stipulated to a dismissal, with prejudice, of this matter, with each party to pay its own costs and fees.

Therefore, pursuant to the parties’ stipulation, this matter is **DISMISSED**.
