**Order of Dismissal**

Global Horizons, Inc., and Mordechai Orian requested a *de novo* hearing on the denial of their application for temporary alien agricultural certification for two workers to plant, cultivate and harvest macadamia nuts for Grassman Farms, Inc., in Naalehu, Hawaii. The Employment and Training Administration accepted the application (Case No. C-06320-03398), but denied it because the applicants have been debarred from the H-2A program for a period of three years. Their motion to stay that debarment was denied on December 26, 2006.

There is no issue for trial, the debarment prevents the certifications sought. The request for hearing is dismissed.
