ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This case was assigned on May 21, 2009, to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision after Employer G.H. Daniels III & Associates, Inc. requested a de novo hearing on the Certifying Officer's denial of its request of for certification of temporary agricultural workers. On May 27, 2009, a conference call was held among the undersigned and counsel for Employer and for Respondent Department of Labor. At that time, counsel requested time to discuss settlement or the submission of additional evidence for consideration. On June 1, 2009, counsel for Respondent informed my law clerk that the Certifying Officer had agreed to certify Employer's request for certification, and that Petitioner would request dismissal.
