ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 15, 2009, Jose & Maria Cantu – Cantu Harvesting (“the Employer”) appealed the Certifying Officer’s determination in the above-captioned temporary labor certification matter. *See* 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B. On May 1, 2009, counsel for the Certifying Officer informed this Office that the Employer had filed another temporary labor certification application for the same job opportunities at issue in the instant case, and that the Certifying Officer would inquire about whether the Employer intended to withdraw the appeal. On May 14, 2009, the Employer filed a letter requesting that this Office “cancel the appeal.” In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Employer’s appeal is **DISMISSED**.
