**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On January 15, 2009, Sanier St. Louis (“Employer”) filed an appeal of the Certifying Officer’s January 13, 2009, denial of an application for temporary alien labor certification. *See* 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B. During a January 27, 2009, telephone call, Employer requested expedited administrative review. On January 27, 2009, the Certifying Officer submitted the Administrative File. Later that day, the undersigned issued an *Order Setting Briefing Schedule*. Subsequently, the parties contacted this office to report that they had resolved all issues in this matter. On February 6, 2009, the Certifying Officer filed a copy of his January 28, 2009, letter granting labor certification. These developments obviate the need for further proceedings before this office. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that Employer’s request for expedited administrative review is **DISMISSED** as moot.
