ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 31, 2011, Holt Farms, LLC (“the Employer”) filed a request for review in the above-captioned temporary alien labor certification matter. On April 13, 2011, BALCA received notice from the Certifying Officer (“CO”) that based on documentation submitted by the Employer and a re-evaluation of the outstanding issues, the CO determined that the Employer’s H-2A application should be certified. Accordingly, the CO requested dismissal of this appeal on the grounds that it is moot.

On April 13, 2011 counsel for the Employer objected to processing of the dismissal until he conferred with his client. On April 18, 2011 counsel for the Employer indicated his client had received notice of acceptance and therefore counsel was withdrawing his objection.

Therefore, in light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **DISMISSED**.
