ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 24, 2011, Lakeland Yard & Garden (“the Employer”) filed a request for review in the above-captioned temporary alien labor certification matter. On March 9, 2011, BALCA received notice from the Certifying Officer (“CO”) that based on documentation submitted by the Employer and a reevaluation of the outstanding issues, the CO determined that the Employer’s H-2A application should be partially certified.
