ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 31, 2011, Wright Farms (“the Employer”) filed a request for a de novo hearing in the above-captioned temporary alien labor certification matter. On April 13, 2011, the Certifying Officer determined that the application could be certified and requested dismissal of this case on the basis that it is moot. On the same date, the Employer objected to dismissal of any pending appeal until it was able to verify that it actually had received an acceptance or certification letter.
