**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND**

This matter arises under the temporary agricultural guest worker provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184 and 1188, and the implementing regulations set forth at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B (collectively, H-2A program). On August 19, 2014, I held a telephonic conference with the parties. During the conference, the parties indicated that the matter was fully resolved and that they would be seeking a remand to the Certifying Officer for continued processing consistent with their settlement. Given the expedited nature of these proceedings, I authorized the parties to file the motion for remand electronically. Having received and reviewed the request for remand, I find that remand is appropriate and the following order shall enter. It is hereby ORDERED that:

The above captioned matter is REMANDED to the Certifying Officer for continued processing consistent with the terms of the parties' settlement agreement.
