ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND

This matter arises under the temporary agricultural guest worker provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184 and 1188, and the implementing regulations set forth at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B (collectively, H-2A program). An Order Setting Briefing Schedule was issued on April 28, 2015.

On April 29, 2015, the Certifying Officer filed a Motion for Remand, indicating that the Certifying Officer and her counsel have reviewed the case and have determined that the matter should be remanded to the agency for further processing. The Employer has no objection to the motion. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the above-captioned matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for continued processing of the Employer's H-2A application.
