REMAND ORDER

This case arises from the request of Jesus Guerrero (“Employer”) for administrative review of a United States Department of Labor Certifying Officer’s (“the CO”) March 2, 2016, Notice of Denial Letter. The Administrative file was received by me on March 8, 2016. A conference call was held with the parties on March 11, 2016, wherein the parties indicated that the Department was affording the Employer an opportunity to resolve deficiencies in its application.

On March 22, 2016, counsel for the CO filed a Certifying Officer’s Motion for Remand (“Motion for Remand”). The Motion for Remand asserted that the CO and his attorney determined that the Employer’s “H-2A application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for acceptance and continued processing. The [E]mployer agrees that the dates of need will be modified to March 25, 2016 to October 15, 2016.” Counsel indicated that its Motion for Remand was unopposed.

In light of the foregoing, I find good cause to remand this matter to the CO for further processing. Accordingly, the CO’s Motion for Remand is **GRANTED**.
