**ORDER OF REMAND**

On April 29, 2016, PJR Farms (the “Employer”) filed a request for de novo hearing in the above-captioned temporary alien labor certification matter. This case was assigned to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge. A de novo hearing is currently scheduled for May 11, 2016.

On May 6, 2016, Attorney Vincent C. Costantino of the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of the Solicitor, Employment and Training Legal Services, (“Solicitor”) filed a Motion stating that the “Certifying Officer and her attorney have reviewed the above referenced case and have determined that the employers’ H-2A application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for continued processing.” The Solicitor also stated that the employer’s representative has been contacted and has no objection to this request.

Accordingly, the above-captioned temporary labor certification case is remanded to the Certifying Officer for further processing. The May 11, 2016 hearing is cancelled.
