ORDER OF REMAND

On April 5, 2016, Bruce Young Farm, (“the Employer”) filed a request for de novo hearing in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter. By Order dated April 14, 2016, I scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for April 20, 2016. On April 19, 2016, the Employer’s counsel informed this office, via a telephone call, that the parties have settled. I held a conference call on April 20, 2016. Participating in the conference were the Certifying Officer’s representative (Amanda Buttler, Esq.) and the Employer’s counsel (Wendel Hall, Esq.). At the conference, the parties reiterated that they have agreed to remand the case.

On April 21, 2016, this office received a Joint Motion for Remand from the Employer’s counsel, indicating that the Certifying Officer has agreed the Employer’s application should be remanded for further processing. The Employer’s counsel averred that the Certifying Officer’s representative has no objection to the request. In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED**.
