**ORDER OF REMAND**

This matter is before me on administrative review. On April 25, 2016, the Employment and Training Administration's Certifying Officer moved (through the Solicitor of Labor) for a remand. The Certifying Officer states that additional processing is required at ETA. Employer does not object to the remand.

The Certifying Officer does not state that Employer has adequately met the deficiencies ETA noted on the H-2A Temporary Labor Certification application. Nor does the Certifying Officer state what more needs to be done at ETA. Generally, some explanation is required to delay an administrative review with a remand. Expedited handling is crucial to the process.

Nonetheless, as Employer has no objection, ETA's motion is GRANTED. This matter is REMANDED to the Employment and Training Administration to complete its processing. This order will be served on the Solicitor and on Employer's counsel by email. All other service is by U.S. mail.
