DECISION AND ORDER REMANDING CASE

On April 13, 2016, the Office of Administrative Law Judges received a letter from Steve Jansa Farms (“Employer”) requesting expedited administrative review of the Final Determination issued by the Certifying Officer in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184(c)(1), 1188 and the implementing regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Labor (“DOL” or “Department”), Employment and Training Administration (“ETA”) at 20 C.F.R. Part 655. The undersigned received the Administrative File in this matter on April 20, 2016. On April 21, 2016, I issued a Notice of Docketing and Order Setting the Briefing Schedule.

On April 26, 2016, counsel for the Certifying Officer (“the Solicitor”) filed a motion requesting that this case be remanded to the agency for additional processing of the employer’s H-2A application. The Employer has no objection to the Solicitor’s request.

ORDER

Accordingly, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for additional processing consistent with the agreement of the parties.
