ORDER OF REMAND

On February 10, 2017, Monty Vallot's Farms and William Vallot, Jr. Farms ("the Employer") filed a request for de novo hearing in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter. On September 23, 2017, this office electronically received a "Motion For Remand" ("Motion") from the Certifying Officer indicating that the parties have reached an agreement in the above captioned case and determined that the Employer's H-2A application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for additional processing. The Motion indicated that the Employer's representative has no objection to the remand request.

Accordingly, the Certifying Officer's Motion is GRANTED and this matter is **REMANDED** to the agency for further processing of the Employer's H-2A application.
