**DECISION AND ORDER OF REMAND**

On April 12, 2017, the Employer filed a request for administrative review or a de novo hearing of the Certifying Officer's denial in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter. On April 13, 2017, the undersigned issued a *Notice of Docketing and Order Setting Briefing Schedule*. On April 17, 2017, the Certifying Officer filed *Certifying Officer's Motion for Remand*, stating, in pertinent part:

The Certifying Officer and his attorney have reviewed the above referenced case and have determined that the employers' H-2A application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for further processing. The employer was contacted and has no objection to the granting of this request.

THEREFORE, the Certifying Officer respectfully requests that this case be remanded to the agency for further processing of the employer's H-2A application.

Accordingly, the Certifying Officer's motion **IS HEREBY GRANTED** and this matter is **REMANDED** to the agency for further processing of the H-2A application.
