ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 17, 2018, I issued an Order to Show Cause directed to Employer in this BALCA appeal on an H-2A application. I required Employer to state whether it seeks administrative review or a hearing *de novo*. Employer timely responded that it sought administrative review.

Subsequently, on September 4, 2018, Employer submitted in writing (email) through its representative a statement that it wishes to withdraw the application. The applicable regulations allow a withdrawal before adjudication. *See* 20 C.F.R. § 655.62. The regulation requires the request to be in writing; Employer has satisfied this requirement. Accordingly,

Employer JHS Harvesting LLC's voluntary withdrawal of the application is ACCEPTED. This matter is DISMISSED.
