ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND

This matter arise sunder the temporary agricultural guest worker provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184 and 1188, and the implementing regulations set forth at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B (collectively, H-2A program).

On March 5, 2018, Rouge River Farms, Inc. (“Employer”) filed a request for administrative review of the Certifying Officer’s issuance of a partial certification of the Employer’s H2-A Application for Temporary Certification. The Employer’s request for administrative review sought a remand to the Certifying Officer for further action. On March 7, 2018, the Certifying Officer filed an Unopposed Motion for Remand stating the parties have agreed the Employer’s H2-A Application for Temporary Certification should be remanded to the agency for further processing.

Therefore, upon consideration, the Certifying Officers Unopposed Motion for Remand is **GRANTED** ad the matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for further action.
