NOTICE OF DOCKETING AND ORDER OF REMAND

On June 20, 2019, the above named Employer requested a *de novo* hearing on the Certifying Officer's decision in the above captioned H-2A temporary labor certification matter. See 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1188; 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(b). This case has been assigned to Administrative Law Judge Patricia J. Daum for hearing and decision.

The undersigned has not yet received the administrative file in this matter. On June 26, 2019, the undersigned received by FAXED communication, the Certifying Officer's Motion for Remand in the above-captioned H-2A matter. In said motion, counsel for the Certifying Officer, Attorney Micole Allekotte, of the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of the Solicitor, Employment and Training legal Services ("Solicitor"), stated that the "Certifying Officer has determined that the Employer's H-2A application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for additional processing."
