ORDER REMANDING CASE

On December 27, 2018, Landis McDonald requested a *de novo* hearing on the Certifying Officer's decision in the above captioned H-2A temporary labor certification matter. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1188; 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(b).
