ORDER OF REMAND

On February 1, 2019, Nash Cattle Co. (“Employer”) requested a *de novo* hearing on the Certifying Officer’s Denial of Certification in the above captioned H-2A temporary labor certification matter. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1188; 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(b). A hearing in this matter is scheduled for Friday, March 8, 2019 at 9:00 a.m.

However, on March 7, 2019, the Certifying Officer filed a Motion to Remand. The Certifying Officer attested that it had reached an agreement with Employer, who had no objection to this matter being remanded to the agency for additional processing. Accordingly, this matter is **REMANDED** for further processing of the Employer’s H-2A application.
