**ORDER OF REMAND**

On December 14, 2018, the above-captioned Employer requested a *de novo* hearing on the Certifying Officer's Notice of Deficiency in the above captioned H-2A temporary labor certification matter. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1188; 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(b). On January 16, 2019, the undersigned issued a Notice of Hearing, setting an expedited hearing on January 24, 2019.

However, on January 23, 2019, the Certifying Officer filed a Motion to Remand. The Certifying Officer attested that it had reached an agreement with Employer, who had no objection to this matter being remanded to the agency for additional processing. Accordingly, this matter is **REMANDED** for further processing of the Employer's H-2A application.
