ORDER REMANDING CASE

On December 28, 2018, D & S Buckmiere Farm (“Employer”) requested a *de novo* hearing on the Certifying Officer’s decision in the above captioned H-2A temporary labor certification matter. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1188; 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(b). I held a conference call with the parties to discuss a hearing date on January 30, 2019, where I learned that the parties had resolved the matter. On January 30, 2019, the Certifying Officer filed a request to remand the matter to the Agency for additional processing. Employer agreed to the remand.

Therefore, based upon the request, the matter is remanded to the Employment and Training Administration for further processing. All dates are vacated. This matter is closed.
