ORDER of REMAND

A telephonic hearing in the above-captioned matter was scheduled for Friday, September 6, 2019 in Omaha, Nebraska. Shortly before the hearing, I received the Certifying Officer's motion for remand, advising that the parties had reached an agreement that the matter should be returned to the Certifying Officer for additional processing. The parties called into the scheduled hearing as requested,¹ and I indicated at that time that the motion would be granted; however, because the Newport News office of OALJ was closed due to the approach of Hurricane Dorian, I advised the parties that a written order would not be issued until Monday, September 9. Counsel agreed that they could use my verbal order to begin the additional processing.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that my verbal order of September 6, 2019 remanding this matter is CONFIRMED, and this matter is REMANDED to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.
