ORDER REMANDING CLAIM

B & W Quality Growers, Inc. (“the Employer”) requested a de novo hearing regarding the Certifying Officer’s decision in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter.¹ This matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Peter B. Silvain, Jr. for hearing and decision. On February 21, 2020, I issued a Notice of Docketing. This Office never received the Administrative File from the Certifying Officer.

On March 2, 2020, counsel for the Certifying Officer (the “Solicitor”) filed a motion requesting that this case be remanded to the Certifying Officer for continued processing. The Solicitor stated that the Employer agreed that its Application for Temporary Labor Certification (“Application”) should be remanded to the agency for further processing.

In light of the agreement reached by the parties, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.
