ORDER OF REMAND

Employer Bluff View Farm timely appealed the Certifying Officer's April 21, 2020, denial of an extension request for three farmworkers under the H-2A non-immigrant program. The H-2A program permits employers to hire foreign workers to perform temporary agricultural work within the United States on a seasonal or other temporary basis. *See* 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a); 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B.

I was assigned this case on May 11, 2020.

By motion from the Certifying Officer dated May 12, 2020, the Employer and Certifying Officer have agreed to and request a remand for further processing. *See* 20 C.F.R. § 655.170.

The motion for remand is GRANTED and this matter is remanded to the Certifying Officer. *See* 20 C.F.R § 655.171(b)(2).
