ORDER REMANDING CASE

This matter arises under the labor certification program for temporary agricultural labor or services in the United States under the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101 *et seq.*, commonly referred to as the H-2A program, and is not currently set for hearing.

On October 6, 2020, the Certifying Officer, through counsel, filed the *Certifying Officer's Motion for Remand* (the "Motion"). Counsel informed the undersigned that the Certifying Officer and the Employer have agreed that the Employer's application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for additional processing and that Employer has no objection to the Motion.

Accordingly, and good cause appearing, the Motion for Remand is GRANTED, and this case is REMANDED to the agency for further processing.
