**ORDER GRANTING CERTIFYING OFFICER'S MOTION FOR REMAND**

This matter arises under provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act governing temporary agricultural employment of non-immigrant workers ("H-2A workers"), and the corresponding regulations at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184, 1188. On February 20, 2020, I issued a Notice of Docketing and Preliminary Order, in which a preliminary conference call was set for February 25, 2020 at 11:30AM. The same day, the Certifying Officer ("CO") filed a Motion for Remand indicating that the parties had reached an agreement and the case should be remanded to the agency for additional processing. Employer has no objection to the CO's request.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for further action consistent with the parties' understanding, and the preliminary conference call scheduled for February 25, 2020 is **CANCELLED**.
