ORDER GRANTING CERTIFYING OFFICER'S MOTION FOR REMAND

This matter arises under provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act governing temporary agricultural employment of non-immigrant workers ("H-2A workers"), and the corresponding regulations at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart B. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184, 1188. On August 31, 2020, the Certifying Officer ("CO") filed a Motion for Remand indicating that the parties had reached an agreement and the case should be remanded to the agency for additional processing. Employer has no objection to the CO's request. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for further action consistent with the parties' understanding.
