ORDER VACATING HEARING AND REMANDING CASE

This matter arises under the labor certification program for temporary agricultural labor or services in the United States under the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101 *et seq.*, commonly referred to as the H-2A program. Hearing is scheduled for December 19, 2019.

On December 18, 2019, the Certifying Officer filed a Motion for Remand, stating that the parties have reached agreement in this case and that Employer, through counsel, had no objection to the matter being remanded to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.

Accordingly, and good cause appearing, the Motion for Remand is GRANTED. The hearing is VACATED, and the case is REMANDED to the Certifying Officer.
