**ORDER REMANDING CASE**

Overlook Harvesting Company, Inc. (“Employer”) submitted an application for temporary labor certification pursuant to the H-2A temporary agricultural worker program. The Certifying Officer denied Employer’s application. Employer then requested a *de novo* administrative review of the decision. Subsequently, the Certifying Officer filed a Motion to Remand. The motion indicates that the parties agree that the matter should be remanded for further processing. Upon a review of the record, the undersigned **GRANTS** the Motion to Remand. The undersigned **REMANDS** this matter to the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Office of Foreign Labor Certification for further processing consistent with the agreement reached by the parties.
