**ORDER OF REMAND**

On October 26, 2020, the Employment and Training Administration, USDOL, received a filing from EAM Harvesting LLC (the “Employer”) requesting an expedited de novo hearing appealing the Certifying Officer’s Notice of Decision in the above-captioned H-2A temporary labor certification matter. ETA forwarded the appeal to the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”), which docketed the appeal on October 26, 2020.

BALCA transferred the case to the San Francisco District Office, where it was assigned to me on October 27, 2020.

By motion dated October 29, 2020, the Certifying Officer moved to remand this case for further processing. *See* 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(a); *see also* 29 C.F.R. § 18.33(c). Employer does not oppose. *Id.*

The motion is GRANTED, and this case is remanded to the Certifying Officer.
