ORDER OF REMAND

This matter arises on Employer's request for expedited administrative review of the Denial of Employer's long term extension request issued by the Certifying Officer in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter. On November 9, 2020, the CO filed an Unopposed Motion to Remand for Further Processing. The motion states that the CO requests that this matter be remanded for further processing, and Employer does not oppose the request.
