REMAND ORDER

JW Enterprise (“Employer”) submitted an application for temporary labor certification pursuant to the H-2A temporary agricultural worker program. The Certifying Officer denied Employer’s application. Employer then sought review of the decision with the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”). As a member of BALCA, the undersigned set the matter for hearing on December 2, 2020.

The Certifying Officer now moves to remand this matter for further agency processing. Employer agrees to the remand. Upon a review of the record, the undersigned **GRANTS** the Motion to Remand. The undersigned **VACATES** the December 2, 2020, hearing and **REMANDS** this matter to the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Office of Foreign Labor Certification for further processing consistent with the agreement reached by the parties.
