ORDER OF REMAND

This appeal is before the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals on Pacific Tomato Growers, Ltd.'s application for a certification under the H-2A temporary agricultural labor certification program. Employer requested a *de novo* hearing before the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals. *See* 20 C.F.R. § 655.171(b). On December 15, 2020, the Certifying Officer moved to remand for additional processing. The Certifying Officer states that the parties have reached an agreement to move the process forward on remand.
