ORDER OF REMAND

On October 6, 2009, the Board received a letter from the attorney for the Certifying Officer ("the CO") stating that upon further review, the CO has concluded that he will be able to partially grant the temporary labor certification sought by the Employer, reduced by four workers. The letter states that "We have consulted with the

attorney for the employer who was amenable to the partial certification.”¹ The CO therefore requested that the matter be remanded to the CO so that partial certification may be granted.

Accordingly, the appeal in the above-captioned matter is **DISMISSED** and this matter is **REMANDED** to the CO for the issuance of partial labor certification.
