ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND

On April 7, 2009, the Certifying Officer (“the CO”) filed a letter requesting that I remand this case to allow him to reconsider the above-named Employer’s application. Therein, the CO explained that the he initially denied the application because the Employer did not respond to his Request for Information (“RFI”). The Employer alleges that it did respond to the RFI and attached the response it allegedly submitted to its request for review by the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals. The CO requests an opportunity to reconsider the application along with the materials allegedly submitted in response to the RFI. The CO stated that the Employer’s representative expressed no objection to this proposal. In light of the foregoing, the CO’s request is hereby **GRANTED**, and this matter is **REMANDED** to the CO. **SO ORDERED.**
