**ORDER OF REMAND**

On November 30, 2011, Alpha Services, LLC (“the Employer”) filed a request for review in the above-captioned temporary alien labor certification matter. On December 8, 2011, BALCA received a request for remand from counsel for the Certifying Officer (“CO”) in order to grant certification. Counsel for the CO stated that the Employer’s application will be certified for 489 workers, rather than the 510 workers originally requested by the Employer. Counsel for the CO stated that he discussed this matter with the Employer’s agent, Ms. Ginny Mullenburg, who indicated that the Employer agrees to the partial certification for 489 workers.

In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** for partial certification.
