ORDER OF REMAND

This case involves the labor certification for temporary employment of nonimmigrant foreign workers (H-2B workers) under the Immigration and Nationality Act (“INA”), as amended, 8 USC § 1101, et seq., and its implementing regulations at 20 CFR § 655, Subpart A. On December 30, 2014, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”) received a letter from the Employer requesting administrative review of the Certifying Officer’s Final Determination in the above-captioned matter.

On January 16, 2015, counsel for the Solicitor filed correspondence with the Board indicating that the Certifying Office (“CO”) requested that this case be remanded for certification. On January 27, 2015, counsel for Employer agreed to the request to remand via telephone. Accordingly, this matter is hereby **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer.
