ORDER OF REMAND

On November 30, 2015, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”) received a request for administrative review of the Certifying Officer’s Notice of Deficiency in the above-captioned H-2B temporary labor certification matter.¹ This case was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Steven D. Bell on December 3, 2015.

On December 18, 2015, counsel for the Certifying Officer (“the Solicitor”) filed a motion requesting that this case be remanded to the Certifying Officer for additional processing. Counsel for the Employer has no objection to the Solicitor’s request. In light of the foregoing, I hereby **REMAND** this matter to the Certifying Officer for additional processing consistent with the agreement of the parties.
