NOTICE OF ASSIGNMENT AND
ORDER OF REMAND

On August 30, 2017, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”) received a letter from Malvern C. Burnett, Esq. on behalf of Jesus Zarraga (the “Employer”) requesting administrative review of the Certifying Officer’s Final Determination in the above-captioned H-2B temporary labor certification matter. BALCA docketed the appeal and the matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Richard A. Morgan.

The undersigned has not yet received the Appeal File. However, on August 31, 2017, Counsel for the Certifying Officer, Attorney Heather Filemyr, of the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of the Solicitor, Employment and Training Legal Services (“Solicitor”), filed a Motion for Remand stating that the “Certifying Officer and the Employer have reached an agreement in the above-referenced case and have determined that the Employer’s application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for additional processing. The Solicitor further states that the Employer’s Counsel has been contacted and has no objection to this Motion.

In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.
