ORDER OF REMAND FOR FURTHER PROCESSING

On September 28, 2017, Peninsula Equine, Inc. ("the Employer") filed a request for administrative review pursuant to 20 C.F.R. § 655.61 in the above-captioned H-2B temporary alien labor certification matter. An initial conference call was held on October 3, 2017, where the parties discussed a possibility of remand to the Certifying Officer for resolution. On October 4, 2017, BALCA received notice that the Certifying Officer has agreed to remand the Employer's application for further processing. The Certifying Officer indicated that the Employer's representative has no objection to its request.
