ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND

This case arises from the Employer's request for review of the Certifying Officer's ("CO") denial of its application for H-2B temporary labor certification. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b), 1103(a), 1184(a)(c); 8 C.F.R. § 214.2(h); 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart A.

On February 24, 2017, the CO filed a Motion for Remand, indicating the parties had reached an agreement in the matter and requesting the case be remanded to the CO for further processing. The CO stated that the Employer has no objection to the Motion.

Having reviewed the Motion for Remand, I find that remand is appropriate. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the above-captioned matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for continued processing.
