ORDER OF REMAND

On March 26, 2019, Bowd Hotels, LLC (Employer) filed a request for administrative review pursuant to 20 C.F.R. § 655.61 in the above-captioned H-2B temporary alien labor certification matter. On April 10, 2019, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (BALCA) received a motion from counsel for the Certifying Officer requesting that Employer's application for temporary certification be remanded to the agency for further processing. The Certifying Officer represented that Employer has no objection to the granting of the motion.

In light of the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED that this matter is REMANDED to the Employment and Training Administration, Office of Foreign Labor Certification, for further processing of Employer's H-2B application.
