ORDER OF REMAND

On March 20, 2019, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”) received an appeal of the Certifying Officer’s Final Determination in the above-captioned H-2B temporary labor certification matter.¹ This case was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Steven D. Bell on March 22, 2019.

On April 5, 2019, counsel for the Certifying Officer (“the Solicitor”) filed a motion requesting that this case be remanded to the Certifying Officer for additional processing. Counsel for the Employer has no objection to the Solicitor’s request. In light of the foregoing, I hereby **REMAND** this matter to the Certifying Officer for additional processing consistent with the agreement of the parties.
