**NOTICE OF ASSIGNMENT AND ORDER OF REMAND**

On March 12, 2019, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”) received a request for review dated March 7, 2019, from Amy J. Novak, Esq., on behalf of Applebrook Associates, LLC DBA Applebrook Golf Course (“Employer”), requesting administrative review of the Certifying Officer’s March 5, 2019 Final Determination Denial in the above-captioned H-2B temporary labor certification matter. Notice is hereby provided that BALCA has docketed the appeal. This matter has been assigned to Administrative Law Judge Sean M. Ramaley.

The undersigned has not yet received the Appeal File. On March 18, 2019, the undersigned received by email filing to [OALJ-filings@OALJ.gov](mailto:OALJ-filings@OALJ.gov), the Certifying Officer’s Unopposed Motion for Remand in the above-captioned H-2B temporary labor certification matter. In said motion, counsel for the Certifying Officer, Attorney Sarah M. Tunney, of the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of the Solicitor, Employment and Training legal Services (“Solicitor”), stated that the “Certifying Officer (“CO”) and Applebrook Associates, LLC DBA Applebrook Golf Course (“Employer”) have agreed that the Employer’s H-2B application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the agency for additional processing.” The Solicitor further states that the Employer’s representative has been contacted and has no objection to this Motion.

In light of the foregoing, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.
