ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO REMAND

This case arises from the Employer's request for review of the Certifying Officer's ("CO") denial of its application for H-2B temporary labor certification. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b), 1103(a), 1184(c); 8 C.F.R. § 214.2(h); 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart A.

On December 17, 2018, the CO served a Motion for Remand, indicating the parties had jointly agreed that the case should be remanded to the CO.
