**ORDER REMANDING CASE**

This matter arises under the labor certification program for temporary non-agricultural employment in the United States under the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101 *et seq.*, and the associated regulations promulgated by the Department of Labor at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart A. The Certifying Officer in the Office of Foreign Labor Certification denied the request to extend a previously granted temporary employment certification to December 15, 2019. Leo O'Laughlin, Inc. appealed the decision of the Certifying Officer. Subsequently, the parties filed a Motion to Remand. The Certifying Officer and Leo O'Laughlin, Inc. request that the undersigned remand this matter to the Office of Foreign Labor Certification for additional processing. Upon a review of the record, the undersigned **GRANTS** the Motion to Remand. The undersigned **REMANDS** this matter to the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Office of Foreign Labor Certification for further processing consistent with the agreement reached by the parties.
