ORDER REMANDING CASE

On January 22, 2019, the Certifying Officer for the Office of Foreign Labor Certification denied the H-2B Application for Temporary Employment Certification (“Application”) of Screws & Stiletto (“Employer”) because it failed to conduct the required recruitment within 14 days of the date of the Notice of Acceptance. 20 C.F.R. § 655.40(b); *see also* 20 C.F.R. §§ 655.42–655.46. Employer timely requested administrative review on February 5, 2019.

On February 25, 2019, the Certifying Officer filed a Motion for Remand, representing that the parties reached an agreement that Employer’s Application should be remanded to the agency for additional processing. The Certifying Officer represented that Employer has no objection to the motion.

Accordingly, this matter is remanded to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.
